

LATIN AND VERNACULAR IN RENAISSANCE IBERIA V: PASTORAL FROM THE MIDDLE AGES TO THE BAROQUE

Following the success of Latin and Vernacular in Renaissance Iberia I -IV (1998-2009), we propose a fifth conference to focus on one particular genre, to be held at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona on 28-29 February 2012.

Up to twelve papers of twenty-five minutes, in English, Spanish or Catalan, are invited on the reception and influence of Latin pastoral literature (classical and modern) on the vernacular and Latin authors of the Iberian Peninsula. The period of reception will be 1400 to 1600. Possible topics are: aemulatio; editions, commentaries and translations; Virgil and Neo-latin pastoral literature; the use of Latin pastoral in the school and university curriculum. Submissions from postgraduate students will be welcomed.
